## **David Barbano Receives ADSA Fellow Award**

**Savoy, IL** – The American Dairy Science Association is proud to announce David Barbano as one of the 2008 recipients of the ADSA Fellow Award. The award was presented on Wednesday, July 11, 2008, during the awards ceremony at the ADSA Annual Meeting in Indianapolis, Indiana.

The purpose of the ADSA Fellow Award is to recognize Dairy Foods Division and Production Division members of the American Dairy Science Association who have rendered distinguished service to the dairy industry over 20 years or more. The winner must have made exceptional contributions to the dairy industry, to a dairy related discipline, or the American Dairy Science Association; in addition, the winner must be and have been a member of the American Dairy Science Association for a minimum of twenty years.

David M. Barbano is professor of food science at Cornell University. Throughout his productive career in research, extension, and teaching, Barbano has demonstrated excellence in integrating research and extension to accomplish measurable positive economic outcomes for the dairy industry in New York State and across the nation. Dairy scientists have benefitted from his leadership within ADSA, with Barbano having served as its recent president, his direction of the North East Dairy Foods Research Center, his mentoring of students, and his publication of significant dairy foods research findings. David Barbano is exceptionally well qualified to be named an ADSA Fellow.
