David B. Carlson Receives Alltech, Inc. Graduate Student Paper Publication Award

Savoy, IL – The American Dairy Science Association is proud to announce David B. Carlson as the 2008 recipient of the Alltech, Inc. Graduate Student Paper Publication Award. The award was presented on Wednesday, July 11, 2008, during the awards ceremony at the ADSA Annual Meeting in Indianapolis, Indiana.

The Alltech, Inc. Graduate Student Paper Publication Award recognizes a graduate student who has published a paper in the Journal of Dairy Science. The manuscript must be based on research conducted by the student before his or her final oral examination and must list the student as senior author.

David B. Carlson received his BS and MS degrees in animal science from North Dakota State University in 2000 and 2002, respectively. David continued for a PhD degree at the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign under the advisement of James Drackley. His PhD research involved a series of experiments that evaluated the effects of L-carnitine supplementation on liver lipid accumulation and specific aspects of hepatic macronutrient metabolism in feed-restricted and periparturient dairy cows. David received his PhD in December 2006, and is now technical services manager for Milk Products Inc., a private-label milk replacer manufacturer based in Chilton, Wisconsin.
