Dr. Michael F. Hutjens Receives ADSA Award of Honor

Champaign, IL – The American Dairy Science Association is proud to announce Dr. Michael F. Hutjens as the 2009 recipient of the ADSA Award of Honor. The award was presented on Tuesday, July 14, 2009, during the awards ceremony at the ADSA Annual Meeting in Montreal, QC, Canada.

The ADSA Award of Honor was created to recognize unusually outstanding and consistent contributions to the welfare of the Association or distinguished service to the Association. The award is primarily for services to the American Dairy Science Association, with career achievements or contributions to other segments of the dairy industry receiving secondary consideration. The winner must have been a member of ADSA for twenty-five or more years, and have served the American Dairy Science Association with unusual distinction.

Hutjens has served as a board member, vice president, president, and past president of ADSA, as president of the Midwest branch, and on numerous ADSA committees, and he assisted with the ADSA Foundation Auction over the course of his 41-year membership. Hutjens has also served on the FASS board of directors. Hutjens has been recognized with three ADSA awards and last year was recognized as an ADSA Fellow.
