### **Dr. D. Wayne Kellogg Receives ADSA Fellow Award**

**Champaign, IL** – The American Dairy Science Association is proud to announce Dr. D. Wayne Kellogg as the 2009 recipient of the ADSA Fellow award. The award was presented on Tuesday, July 14, 2009, during the awards ceremony at the ADSA Annual Meeting in Montreal, QC, Canada.

The purpose of the ADSA Fellow Award is to recognize Dairy Foods Division and Production Division members of the American Dairy Science Association who have rendered distinguished service to the dairy industry over 20 years or more. The winner must have made exceptional contributions to the dairy industry, to a dairy related discipline, or the American Dairy Science Association; in addition, the winner must be and have been a member of the American Dairy Science Association for a minimum of twenty years.

D. Wayne Kellogg is professor of animal sciences at the University of Arkansas. Throughout his academic career, Kellogg has made many and varied distinguished contributions to the dairy industry. He has served as senior editor of the Journal of Dairy Science and president of the American Registry of Professional Animal Scientists. Kellogg's teaching and research activities have focused on dairy cattle nutrition including work on forages, minerals, and protein by-products. Kellogg has authored or coauthored 81 refereed scientific articles, and he has mentored 37 graduate students. He has been a member of ADSA for over 40 years.
