### **Dr. Dale Olver Receives Land O'Lakes, Purina Feed LLC Teaching Award in Dairy Production**

The winner must have demonstrated outstanding ability as a teacher of undergraduate students of dairy science in an accredited college or university, been an active teacher when nominated with not less than a total of ten years of active teaching preceding, and been a member of the American Dairy Science Association for at least five successive years.

Dale Olver is an instructor of dairy and animal science at Penn State University. He is known for his enthusiastic approach and commitment to students. Olver is the primary instructor or a major co-instructor of nine animal science or general courses in the College of Agricultural Sciences. He strives to integrate scientific principles with industry trends to create an active learning environment. In addition, he coaches the Penn State dairy cattle judging team and is co-advisor of the Penn State Dairy Science Club, where he has mentored numerous ADSA Student Affiliate Division officers and Undergraduate Presentation Contest winners.
