Dr. Federico M. Harte Receives ADSA Foundation Scholar Award in Dairy Foods

Champaign, IL – The American Dairy Science Association is pleased to announce Dr. Federico M. Harte as the 2010 recipient of the ADSA Foundation Scholar Award in Dairy Foods. The award was presented on Tuesday, July 13, 2010, during the awards ceremony at the ADSA Annual Meeting in Denver, Colorado.

The ADSA Foundation Scholar Award in Dairy Foods was created to recognize a young scholar from the Dairy Foods Division and their potential in research and educational leadership, and to identify critical issues affecting the future of the dairy industry. Special requirements include a ten year or less post-final academic degree, current active membership in the American Dairy Science Association, exemplary research and/or educational programs (instruction, extension, or industry), and potential for future leadership.

Harte is an assistant professor in the Department of Food Science and Technology at The University of Tennessee, Knoxville. Harte earned his BS in agricultural engineering at the University of Uruguay in 1995 and his PhD in engineering sciences from the Program in Food Engineering, Department of Biological Systems Engineering at Washington State University in 2002. He has established a highly prolific program in dairy foods engineering and has published 32 peer-reviewed journal papers, 6 book chapters, and numerous abstracts and conference proceedings.
