



2006 ADSA AWARDS

The 2006 Joint Annual Meeting of the American Dairy Science Association AND the American Society of Animal Science convened July 9 through July 13 of 2006 at the Minneapolis Convention Center in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Over 2,800 attendees representing nearly every country in the world attended the Joint Annual Meeting.

The meeting hosted 30 symposia, almost 1,500 oral and poster presentations (including 47 ADSA Centennial posters) and 74 commercial and educational exhibits. Among the many special events were opening and closing sessions and an international reception; annual general meetings for each of the host societies; a dance with the Johnny Holm Band, a 5K Fun Run; a spouses' high tea; several special breakfasts for university alumni; award ceremonies for ADSA and ASAS; the ADSA Town Hall Meeting; and the annual ADSA auction, raffle, and an old-fashioned ice cream social.

The meeting also marked the Centennial of the American Dairy Science Association. The Opening Session focused on the history of ADSA and the dairy science industry; 18 ADSA Pioneers will opened 18 oral scientific sessions with presentations; universities, companies, and dairy clubs displayed 47 posters sharing the history of their organizations' involvement with the dairy industry; and a coffee table book and DVD documentary recounted the history of ADSA and the dairy industry were created.
