



ADSA is pleased to introduce *e-Membership*

Available only through ADSA Global Partner organizations and to individuals who reside outside of the US and Canada, this electronic membership was designed for those who have an interest in dairy science, but may not have the time or budget to attend ADSA's annual meeting, or cost-justify full membership in ADSA due to a different area of specialization.

At a 50% discount from ADSA professional membership dues, an ADSA *e-Member* receives:

Electronic access to the *Journal of Dairy Science*®, (and a paper copy, if desired, for an additional fee);

Access to a treasure trove of synchronized symposia recordings (currently 67 recorded symposia from 2003-2010, with more added each year);

Access to searchable Joint Annual Meeting abstracts for 1998-2009, with more added each year, plus ADSA annual meeting abstracts from 1935-1997, as well as ADSA divisional meeting abstracts;

The opportunity to subscribe to S-PAC® (Searchable Proceedings of Animal Conferences) at the ADSA member rate.

The ADSA *e-Membership* rate is USD 55.

For 2010, JDS was rated by ISI Journal Citation Reports as **number 2** of 55 journals in the Agriculture, Dairy, and Animal Science category, with an impact factor of 2.497! In addition, JDS has been ranked **number 1** for a newly created ISI ranking, the five-year impact factor. And, JDS is ranked **number 1** by Eigenfactor Score, which excludes self-citations.

The dairy foods section of *Journal of Dairy Science* is also ranked by ISI as number 18 of 125 journals in the Food Science and Technology category for 2010, number 16 in five-year impact factor in that category, and an impressive number 3 by Eigenfactor Score.

JDS produced 634 articles in 6,022 scientific pages in 2010 and all issues dating back to 1917 are now online and fully searchable at no additional cost.

S-PAC is the most comprehensive animal production and management conference proceedings database in the world. This unique collection of conference proceedings and presentations is a must-have resource for animal scientists, veterinarians, academicians, consultants and members of industry around the world. As of July 2010, **39 conferences** have contributed **372 sets of proceedings**, with new conferences and proceedings added every month. The value of S-PAC increases every time a conference and a set of proceedings is added. If an ADSA *e-Member* elects to attend the ADSA annual meeting, or an ADSA Discover Conference, the ADSA e-Member must pay additional dues of \$55 (to reach full professional member dues) in order to then pay the ADSA member registration rate. ADSA e-Members are **not** eligible for ADSA member page charge rates or ADSA awards, and are not eligible to run for ADSA board positions, or vote in ADSA elections. Becoming an ADSA e-Member is accomplished online and the membership year runs for 365 days from date of sign-up.
