Champaign, IL – Dairy science students from _____ recently attended the 2010 Annual Meetings of the American Dairy Science Association (ADSA), Poultry Science Association (PSA), Asociación Mexicana de Producción Animal (AMPA), Canadian Society of Animal Science (CSAS), American Society of Animal Science (ASAS), and ASAS Western Section (WSASAS), held together July 11-15, 2010, in Denver, Colorado. The meetings attracted approximately 100 student and advisors in addition to the more than 5000 professionals and guests from the US, Mexico, Canada, and beyond.

During the meetings, the students participated in the Dairy Quiz bowl among dairy clubs, business meetings, various competitions including the Undergraduate Paper Competitions, a Career Symposium where students participated in a roundtable with professionals representing various aspects of industry, and an awards luncheon. Students also attended symposia, oral sessions and poster sessions presented by professional members of the organizations.

The students attended the meetings as members of the American Dairy Science Association Student Affiliate Division (ADSA-SAD). The ADSA-SAD is a division of the parent organization that works to develop leadership and promote scholarship among students interested in the dairy industry, and to encourage students toward careers in dairy science. There are more nearly 500 undergraduate student members in ADSA.

ADSA was established in 1906 as a scientific and educational association to serve the dairy and dairy-related industries. It facilitates the discovery, application and dissemination of dairy science knowledge and information.
