Savoy, IL – Dairy science students from _____ recently attended the combined meetings of the American Dairy Science Association, American Society of Animal Science, Poultry Science Association and Mexican Association of Production in San Antonio. The student meetings were held July 7-10, and attracted nearly 100 student and advisors in addition to the nearly 3500 professionals from the US, Mexico, Canada, and elsewhere.

During the meetings, the students participated in a dairy quiz bowl among dairy clubs, business meetings, various competitions including the Undergraduate Paper Competitions, a Career Symposium where students participated in a roundtable with professionals representing various aspects of industry, an industry job fair in the exhibit hall, and an awards luncheon. Students also attended symposia, oral sessions and poster sessions presented by professional members of the organizations.

The students attended the meetings as members of the American Dairy Science Association Student Affiliate Division (ADSA-SAD). The ADSA-SAD is a division of the parent organization that works to develop leadership and promote scholarship among students interested in the dairy industry, and to encourage students toward careers in dairy science. There are more than 400 undergraduate student members in ADSA.

ADSA was established in 1906 as a scientific and educational association to serve the dairy and dairy-related industries. It facilitates the discovery, application and dissemination of dairy science knowledge and information.
